Chapter Bylaws	<p>Article III- Section 2c: Membership</p> <p>“Retired sorors who are 66 years of age shall pay a reduced amount for chapter dues. The said amount shall be determined at 65% of the current chapter dues. This consideration will not be given to newly initiated sorors or reactivated sorors until they have been a member of Theta Omega Chapter for five years.”</p>	<p>Retired sorors who are 66 years of age, [and who have ten consecutive years of membership in Theta Omega Chapter are eligible to pay] a reduced amount for chapter dues. The [reduced dues amount shall be presented with the annual budget report and voted on by the chapter.]</p>
<p>Rationale</p> <p>The number of sorors eligible for reduced dues will continue to grow. Adjusting the dues reduction rate and membership requirement will slow the financial impact this benefit has on the chapter.</p>
